What is anxiety?

Exercise to boost mood and wellbeing

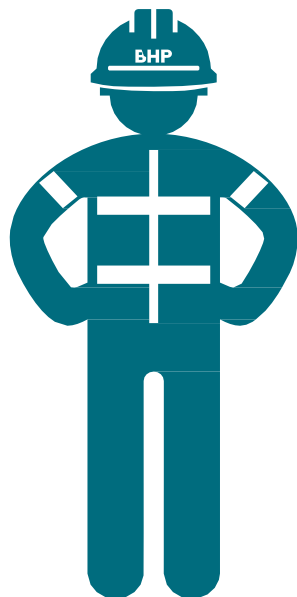
Catch up with friends
